- The Chesapeake Preschool Initiative (CPI) serves at risk 4-year-old children and is located at seven elementary schools. The enrollment figure is for informational purposes.
- The Pre-K program serves children, ages 2-4, with a significant developmental delay in one or more of the following areas: cognitive ability, motor skills, social/adaptive behavior, perceptual skills, and communication skills.
- Students attending one of the two centers are included in the totals for their home rooms. The enrollment figures for these centers are provided for informational purposes.
- Capacities are reviewed annually and may change based on building modifications, instructional program changes, and/or special education needs.
- "Percent of Capacity" represents current monthly enrollment divided by capacity.
- The "Initial LOS Figure" is updated quarterly and is based on the Level of Service Policy formula. It includes the official enrollment count (September 30) and students projected from approved preliminary plans, but does not include the additional number of students projected from proposed rezoning applications.
- Includes portable units used for the Chesapeake Preschool Initiative.
- Enrollment increases in school years 2021-22 and 2022-23 represent the partial recovery of the 2020-21 school year enrollment loss due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
